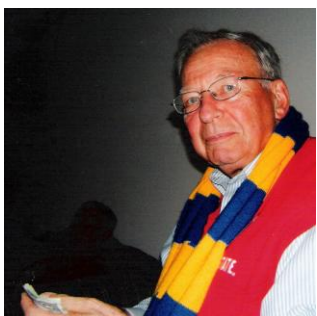
Promoting Buckeye Spirit in Greene County
