- 3:45 - 5:15: Dr. Imel repeats, Dr. Rocco repeats, Dr. Robert Warmbrod (multiple regression), Dr. Susie Whittington (peer review processes)

Patti Lather Keynote

Patti Lather, professor of social and cultural foundations at The Ohio State University's College of Education, will be the opening keynote speaker. The opening session will run from 9 a.m.-10 a.m. in the Fawcett Center auditorium.

Among her publications, Dr. Lather co-authored *Troubling the Angels: Women Living with HIV/AIDS* (1997) with Chris Smithies, which was named a CHOICE Outstanding Academic Book of the Year in 1998. She wrote *Getting Smart: Feminist Research and Pedagogy With/In the Postmodern* (1991), which received a Critics Choice Award from the American Educational Studies Association in 1991.
