The Alumni Association does not guarantee tickets to any regular season or bowl game for any local club around the country. **OUR CLUB IS NOT GUARANTEED TICKETS TO ANY BUCKEYES**

**REGULAR SEASON OR BOWL GAME.** We send a request into the Alumni Association to let them know we would like to be considered for tickets if any are made available to the clubs. Our club ticket policy drafted and ratified on April 16, 2008 is as follows:

### **OSU ALUMNI CLUB OF SACRAMENTO VALLEY TICKET POLICY**

#### **Qualifications:**

To qualify for a ticket lottery a member must be a current member of the local club and not be receiving tickets from another source. Club membership is based on payment of dues. Memberships are paid for the calendar year. To be considered paid for the calendar year, payment must have had been received by the Michigan game. We may not send reminders about payment of dues. Members will also have to meet any requirements set forth by OSUAA.

#### **Ticket allocation:**

1. One half of the tickets secured by the club will be distributed to Board members in good standing based on the following priority schedule.
  - A. All elected officers and Board members of the club are guaranteed 2 tickets per household membership. If there are more officers and board members with an interest in tickets than available tickets a lottery will be held.
  - B. All Board members not receiving tickets as described above may be entered in the regular lottery as described for all other club members.
  
2. All other club members who express an interest in tickets will go into a lottery with the following number of chances.
  - A. All annual local club member households will get 1 chance for 2 tickets.
  - B. One (1) additional chance will be given to club members for each of the following:
    - i. Donating at least \$25. to the scholarship fund for the given year.
    - ii. Attending the annual banquet for the given year.
    - iii. Attending the holiday reception for the given year
  - C. Club members can only receive a maximum of four chances for the lottery.
  - D. All member households are limited to 2 tickets. Tickets must be used by club members or their families.
  - E. Any unused or unclaimed tickets can be used at the discretion of the Board.

**LOTTERY PROCESS:**

The lottery will be announced by email and/or regular mail.

The lottery drawing will be held at a public place with the time and location made known to the interested club members so they may witness the drawing. In addition to the lottery winners, (3) three alternates will be drawn. A lottery winner must return the tickets to the club if unable to use the tickets as specified above.

**WINNER ANNOUNCEMENT:**

The lottery winners and alternates will be announced via email or published on the club website.

**PAYMENT MUST BE AS FOLLOWS:**

For those individual present for the lottery, payment in full must be made in cash or check on the day of the lottery to the designated officer of the club. If the lottery winner is not present for the drawing they must get the payment to the designated club officer within 5 working days of the lottery announcement.

**Failure to adhere to these policies may result in disqualification from future OSU event tickets:** A non-reimbursed bounced check or scalping of the tickets by any member who secures tickets through this process will automatically disqualify them for all future OSU event tickets. Tickets must be used by club members or their families.

For bowl games, we do not anticipate knowing if we will receive tickets or not until mid-December at the earliest. If we are granted the privilege to purchase tickets we will send a blast out as soon as we find out one way or another.
